1. Overview of Duolingo English Test

- **Purpose:** The DET is used to assess English language proficiency for academic and immigration purposes.
- **Online Test:** Can be taken at home, on your own computer.
- **Duration:** Approximately 1 hour.

4. Structure of the Test

- **Adaptive Format:** The test adapts in difficulty based on your answers.

- **Scoring Range:** 10 to 160, in increments of 5.
- **Skills Measured:**

- Literacy (Reading and Writing)
- Comprehension (Listening)
- Conversation (Speaking)
- Production (Overall ability to produce English)

- **Score Availability:** Results are typically available within 48 hours.
